Aim of the challenge

- Encourage students to become **global citizens** by raising awareness of the link between safe water, sanitation and hygiene as a basic human right
- Fundraise for WaterAid so they can continue to work with communities globally
- It gives us an excuse to include some **bad toilet jokes** in the program!

WHO IS WATER AID?

WaterAid is an international not-for-profit, determined to make clean water, decent toilets and good hygiene normal for everyone, everywhere with a generation.

WHAT SUPPORT IS AVAILABLE?

You will receive sponsorship to attend MWKTK for FREE, this means that you won't pay the \$600 registration fee.

We will provide you with **education resources** and link you up with a **WaterAid mentor** to speak to your students about their work, share stories from the people they help and answer any questions.

We encourage you to use recycled materials in the challenge, but Kids Teaching Kids will provide a **\$150 cash grant** towards materials.

What would we have to do?

Before MWKTK

- Learn about water access and sanitation globally
- Do some fundraising within your school and local community
- Challenge your students to build a toilet using recycled materials (NB. Your toilet obviously won't be functional, it's the rationale behind what they build that is more important)
- Put together a 3-minute pitch (eg. a video, rap, drama etc) highlighting the key issues related to access to sanitation and what you focused on with your toilet
- Decide on your favourite toilet joke



At MWKTK

Your students will participate in a 'mainstage' presentation based on the TV program "Shark Tank" (more details to come).

This will be made up of your 3 minute "pitch" followed by 3 or 4 questions from our judges.

*** You will need to bring your toilet on the day (we'll help to figure out the logistics of doing this)**
